## Nomination Notice

### AFGE Local 2782 **Nomination Meeting**

**Nominations** for the offices of President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, 3rd Vice President, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Two (2) Chief Stewards, Delegates and Alternates to Council One, Delegates and Alternates to Metropolitan Washington Council, Delegates and Alternates to 14<sup>th</sup> District Caucus, Delegates and Alternates to the Northern Virginia Central Council and Delegates and Alternates to the AFGE National Convention will be accepted from the floor at the membership meeting on **Thursday, April 19, 2012 at 12:00 p.m., in the Census Headquarters Conference Rooms 1-3.**

**Qualifications** for office are: be a member in good standing of this local, be a member for one year of AFGE Local 2782 immediately preceding the closing of the nomination process; must not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO, candidates shall not run for more than one office in the same local election.

Any member, who has paid dues through April 1, 2012 prior to 4:00 p.m., is in good standing and eligible to nominate candidates and run for office.

A second for a nomination is not required. Self, nominations are permissible. Nominations may also be made in writing, and must be received by Alethea Carter, Election Chair-Person at the AFGE Local Election Committee's Post Office Box, 442 Suitland, MD 20752 no later than 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 17, 2012

Candidates must accept nominations at the nomination meeting or, if not in attendance, submit a written acceptance to Alethea Carter, Election Chair-Person, to be received by the close of nominations on Thursday April 19, 2012. The member making the nomination has the responsibility of informing the nominee of his or her nomination.

The term of office will run for 2 year(s) ending with the installation of officers following the regularly scheduled elections in 2014.

The manual secret ballot election will be conducted on Wednesday, May 30, 2012 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Census Headquarters Conference Room T - 7. Additional information regarding the election will be provided in a separate notice, which will be mailed to all Local 2782 members on a later date.

**Each candidate may have a reasonable number of observers, who are members and are present throughout the election process, including the tally of ballots.**
